Immunizations: Tdap, 2 MMR, 3 Hepatitis B, 2 Varicella (chicken pox), at least 4 DTP, at least 3 Polio, new as of 2015: Meningococcal Vaccine

#### Ninth Grade

Illinois Physical Exam
Immunizations: 2 Varicella Vaccines

#### Twelfth Grade

Immunizations: New as of 2015: 2 Meningococcal Vaccines, if the first was received on or after the 16th birthday, only one is required.

New Illinois State standard for all students receiving physical exams: All students (K, 6th, and 9th grades) will receive an age-appropriate developmental screening and social/emotional screening as required parts of the physical exam.

All children entering 6th through 12th grades shall show proof of Tdap immunization and 2 varicella immunizations.
